Just for fun, don't forget to paint a little green man coming out of the thumbhole of your extra-terrestrial frisbee craft.

You Will Need:

1 packet paper plates
paints or Textas
scissors
craft glue

Way To Go:

- ✂ Leave the packet of paper plates stacked together for a firm surface to work on. You will only need two plates. Turn the packet over so you are drawing on the bottom of the first plate.
- ✂ Draw a rough design on the plate before painting. Paint up design.
- ✂ Cut a U-shaped hole for thumb to be placed into on upper painted plate. Cut out figure to fit in the hole and colour in.
- ✂ Glue a plain bottom plate, right side up, to the top of painted plate, leaving thumb hole open.
