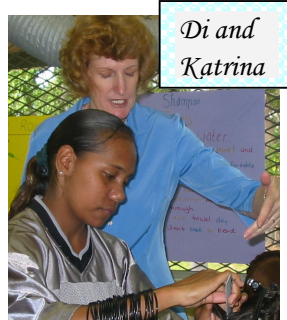
What's happening in the VET class?
