Fact Sheet English as a Second Language

As part of a growing multicultural community, this 8 week course has been designed to provide some opportunities for members, especially those of who are of English as a Second language background to have access to gaining knowledge, skills and understanding of the English language in order to actively participate in society. This will be provided in the way of spoken, written, visual and multimedia texts to help develop some critical understanding of the English Language, enhance communication skills and increase confidence.

Listening

Acquire skills on how to improve listening techniques to facilitate participation in conversations and carrying out directives.

Speaking

Learn how to use intonation and correct pronunciation in both formal and informal situations. Participate in conversations with people of different levels in society on various topics of local, national or international importance.

Reading

Show reading ability of both visual and verbal texts. Improve communication and interactions skills in different contexts. Gain practical experience in understanding different written formats.

Writing

Improve writing skills ranging from filling forms to basic essay. Acquire an ability to interpret knowledge from visual to verbal contexts. Learn formal and informal grammar usage.

You will be expected:

- To attend one class each week
- Participate in practical class activities
- Complete work items
- Practice your social speaking skills
- Practice your negotiation skills
- Develop practical skills & help others develop their skills in a co-operative, sharing way.

Assessment

This is not a certificate course and there is no formal assessment for this course. Due to the flexible nature of Adult Education classes, parts of the curriculum may be adapted to suit the needs of the class.
