Fact Sheet Guitar Basics

Always had a desire to play the guitar? Guitar Basics is for the person who has little or no knowledge of the guitar. At the end of the course you will be able to tune your guitar, play chords, melodies and a song.

This course will give you, the student, an opportunity to learn the basic skills needed to have fun on your guitar. With the relaxed approach taken in group sessions you will find that you will be carried along towards the goals that you set for yourself.

Give yourself the confidence to continue on in the joys of learning your guitar.

This course is very informal and a development of your own style is encouraged.

During this course you will cover the following topics:

An understanding of music, play open cords, and rhythms

Tuning of your guitar and

How to care for your guitar.

There is no need for any previous experience, but a desire to have a go is essential.

Students will be learning together as a group, helping each other to achieve each task.

The underlying principle of this course is "Learn a little - use it a lot". Therefore a few minutes set aside for practice each day will help you consolidate what you learn to achieve a better standard. Individual needs can be focussed on in discussion times, and ideas for solutions to problems will be discussed as they arise in the class.

Items you will need to provide:

Your own guitar

Picks - 2 or 3 medium optional (if western style guitar)

Plastic A4 folder to hold photocopied material (suggested)

An exercise book and pencil (suggested)
