## Fact Sheet Indonesian for Travellers

The main aim of this unit is to provide learners with a solid working competence in basic Indonesian. This will be done in such a way that learners will be able to use the language appropriately, correctly and with some degree of spontaneity and variation. Learners will further be able to interact in a relatively small number of commonly occurring situations when travelling through-out Indonesia.

### **Lesson One:**

How Indonesian sounds and major differences and similarities with English  
Greetings, introductions and farewells  
Pronunciation practice, introducing numbers

### **Lesson Two:**

Practice asking where a person comes from  
Islands of Indonesia  
Thank you and requesting

### **Lesson Three:**

Gain familiarity with the terms for commonly encountered buildings and places and to practice using them in simple conversations

Telling the time

### **Lesson Four:**

To practice asking and answering questions that require a simple "yes" or "no" answer

Things to do and places to go e.g. distance & location

### **Lesson Five:**

Typical Indonesian foods and eating habits  
Ordering meals and drinks in a restaurant  
Applying topical knowledge through role play

### **Lesson Six:**

Using a street directory – asking directions  
Travel by train, bus, taxi, hire car, bicycle  
Buying tickets

### **Lesson Seven:**

Hotels, motels, B & B, youth hostels  
Finding and booking accommodation  
Topical group work highlighting students' progress

### **Lesson Eight:**

Revise all words, phrases, grammar constructions and concepts learned throughout the course

### **Assessment**

This is not a certificate course and there is no formal assessment for this course. Due to the flexible nature of Adult Education classes, parts of the curriculum may be adapted to suit the needs of the class.
