Navigating with GPS for Business and Pleasure

This course is intended for persons who wish to improve their ability to navigate over land and water to pursue outdoor recreational interests such as bush walking, mountain/trail bike riding, off road driving, camping, boating, fishing and hunting.

In recent years global positioning system (GPS) and Google Earth technology have made it possible to navigate with ease and precision to almost any point on the earth's surface

Through a mixture of classroom and field activities and this course aims to provide an understanding of GPS and map fundamentals and to develop practical skills in navigation with a GPS receiver
