Photoshop Introduction

This course is designed for students who wish to acquire the fundamental skills required to operate Photoshop CS2 (8.0)

Photoshop is one of the most widely used graphics-painting programs available. With Adobe Photoshop CS2 (8.0) you can retouch scanned photographs, edit images, create painted artwork and produce special effects.

At the completion of this course you will understand the basic concepts of Photoshop CS2 and have the fundamental skills needed to use this software package effectively.
