Fact Sheet Spanish for Travellers

This course focuses on the practical needs of persons who plan to visit or revisit Spain. A genuine interest in the land and its people is presumed. Students learn to actively participate in lessons - even with no prior language experience. Together we aim to achieve a basic 'Spanish Travel Toolkit' for everyday scenarios.

Each lesson strives to build useful vocabulary and practices listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. Essential grammar and pronunciation points are introduced and tried. A relaxed and enthusiastic approach encourages students to participate at their own pace.

Course Content

Week 1

How Spanish sounds – major differences and similarities with English; greetings, introductions and farewells; pronunciation.

Week 2

Introducing numbers; Asking for and telling time – easy digital method; Thanking and requesting – partner work

Week 3

Let's explore Spain! Places of interest – modes of travel; Essential travel documents; Short travel dialogue – group work

Week 4

Introducing the currency; Changing money – credit cards; Obtaining goods in a variety of outlets; Using bilingual dictionary effectively

Week 5

Typical Spanish foods and eating habits; Ordering meals and drinks in a restaurant; Applying topical knowledge through role play

Week 6

Using a street directory: asking directions; Travel by train, bus, taxi, hire car, bicycle; Buying tickets

Week 7

Hotels, motels, B & B, youth hostels; Finding and booking accommodation; Topical group work highlighting students' progress

Week 8

Revision of course; Special events in Spain

Assessment

This is not a certificate course and there is no formal assessment for this course. Due to the flexible nature of Adult Education classes, parts of the curriculum may be adapted to suit the needs of the class.
