The program

The Centre for Excellence program allows high ability students to achieve excellence in specialist subjects related to their career aspirations, while having the opportunity to focus in their learning program on issues and solutions for a sustainable future.

Year 10

In Year 10 students undertake an introductory unit to prepare them for the innovative and challenging learning opportunities they will encounter in the program. They also undertake a range of general and specialist subjects to assist them in planning for their future career pathways.

Stage 1 and 2

Throughout Stage 1 and Stage 2 students undertake rigorous specialist studies that will challenge and extend them in their learning and prepare them for their future career pathways. They also have opportunities to participate in cross disciplinary studies with a focus on sustainable futures.



Internships

Students have opportunities to participate in an internship program throughout their three years in the program. This involves blocks of supervised training or research in a profession or industry relevant to their career aspirations.



Coaches and Mentors

Each student has a coach to assist with planning their learning and career pathway. They are also assigned a mentor to guide and extend their learning in their area of specialisation.

Partnerships

Partnerships with Charles Darwin University, industry and other agencies provide opportunities for rich learning directly related to career pathways.
